Sec. 66-117 - Snow Removal  
(Code 1983, § 4.62)

Sec. 66-117. - Snow removal.

(a)

Owner responsibility on commercial property. The owner of any property classified as commercial on the current tax roll shall remove all snow and ice from any public sidewalk adjacent to such commercial property, prior to 10:00 a.m., Monday through Saturday.

(b)

Penalty for violation of section. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$250.00.

(c)

Separate offenses. A separate offense shall be deemed committed upon each day during or when a violation occurs or continues.

(d)

Removal by city; costs to constitute lien. The DPW director is hereby authorized and directed to remove any snow or ice on sidewalks, where the owner of adjacent commercial property has failed to comply with this section. The cost for removal shall be billed by the city treasurer to the owner of the adjacent commercial property. Failure to pay for the snow or ice removal shall constitute a lien upon the property and shall be collectable on the tax roll, as provided in this Code.
